Canada Post Strike

Continued support from Reuter Benefits

On Monday, May 30, 2011, the Canadian Union of Postal Workers issued a notice stating that its members were prepared to go on strike at midnight Thursday, June 2, 2011.

In the event of a strike, some Canada Post mail delivery could be discontinued for an unspecified length of time.

Consequently, you may find that alternate delivery methods may be required and you may choose to submit documents to our office or to the insurance carrier using fax, email, or courier.

We would like to remind plan members that any investment changes submitted via paper would not be processed until received by the insurance carrier, so you may choose instead to make changes on-line or send changes to us via email.

Members wishing to make lump-sum deposits to their Retirement Plan(s) may also do so on-line and can contact our office for assistance with this process.
